Enrollment and Fees

Admission is open to any qualified applicant. No qualified person may be excluded from enrollment on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, gender identity and/or expression, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

1. Be at least 18 years of age.
2. Submit required forms (Enrollment Agreements, etc.) as required by state postsecondary regulations.
3. Pay appropriate fees.

It is advisable to contact your state's Appraisal Board, Real Estate Commission or Financial Services Board for information specific to becoming an appraiser or real estate agent in your state.

For this on-line program, all students must complete the enrollment agreement form Programs are accessible to you at any time within the enrollment period. Upon enrolling in the course, you will have 180 days to complete the course and applicable exams, with the ability to purchase extensions up to an additional 180 days. As our courses are taught via distance education, students do not have the calendar constraints common to in-class courses such as program start/end dates and beginning/end dates for terms

Terms of Agreement

1. Mbition LLC, offers several payment options and tuition is required in full prior to the start of any program. Tuition may be paid by check (enrollment would occur upon receipt of your check – we cannot accept checks by phone), or by Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover (credit or debit cards can be processed over the phone or online and enrollment would occur immediately when payment by card is processed).
2. I understand that courses are Internet based and conducted on an independent study basis and I may continue my enrollment for a period of 180 days (approximately 6 months). I understand that I can purchase up to three 90-day course extensions after the initial enrollment period. However, for tuition refund purposes the period of enrollment is 6 months and the following charges will apply:
 1. If I withdraw within the 6 months of enrolling, I will be charged for the actual lessons completed. For refund calculation purposes, I must provide evidence of the number of lessons completed.
 2. If I fail to notify the school that I am withdrawing within 6 months of enrolling I understand that I shall be charged for the total number of contracted lessons and lesson materials.
3. To complete the program, I must clock the required number of instructional hours and complete all required quizzes and final exams (if applicable).

Filing a Complaint with the Kentucky Commission on Proprietary Education

To file a complaint with the Kentucky Commission on Proprietary Education, each person filing must submit a completed "Form to File a Complaint" (PE-24) to the Kentucky Commission on Proprietary Education by mail to 500 Mero Street, 4th Floor Frankfort, KY 40601. This form can be found on the website at www.kcpe.ky.gov.

Student Protection Fund

KRS 165A.450 requires each school licensed by the Kentucky Commission on Proprietary to contribute to a Student Protection Fund which will be used to pay off debt incurred due to the closing of a school, discontinuance of a program, loss of license, or loss of accreditation by a school or program. To file a claim against the Student Protection Fund, each person filing must submit a completed "Form for Claims Against the Student Protection Fund". This form can be found on the website at www.kcpe.ky.gov

Career/Placement Assistance

The school does not aid or provide counseling for graduates in finding job leads or arranging interviews with potential employers. Current law prohibits any school from guaranteeing job placement as an inducement to enroll students.

Credit for Previous Education and Training

Mbition Learn Real Estate does not grant credit for previous education and training. Also, Mbition Learn Real Estate does not guarantee the transferability of its credits to any other education institution. Transferability is up to the receiving institution.
