Enrollment and Fees

Admission is open to any qualified applicant. No qualified person may be excluded from enrollment on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, gender identity and/or expression, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

1. Be at least 18 years of age.
2. Submit required forms (Enrollment Agreements, etc.) as required by state postsecondary regulations.
3. Pay appropriate fees.

It is advisable to contact your state's Appraisal Board, Real Estate Commission or Financial Services Board for information specific to becoming an appraiser or real estate agent in your state.

For this on-line program, all students must complete the enrollment agreement form prior to starting the course.

All course lessons must be completed within 180 days (6 months) from the date of enrollment. Course access will expire at midnight on the 180th day after enrollment. Students must contact Mbition within 30 days of expiration

to obtain an extension. Access to the course after 30 days from initial expiration requires re-enrollment. A discounted fee of 50% of the original purchase price will be charged.

The maximum time to complete a course, including any eligible extensions and completion of the final exam, is 12 months (180 days + purchase of three 60-day extensions). The 60-day extension period begins from the date your course originally expires. It is your responsibility to contact Mbition Learn Real Estate to request an extension. It is recommended you purchase the extension immediately after the course has expired in order to be able to have the full 60 days of the extension. Access to a course after the extension period(s) requires re-enrollment. A discounted re-enrollment fee of 50% of the original purchase price will be charged.

If you are not eligible for an extension due to regulatory requirements, then you will be eligible to re-purchase the course with a discounted re-enrollment fee at 50% of the original purchase price.

Terms of Agreement

1. Mbition LLC offers several payment options and tuition is required in full prior to the start of any
 - a. program. Tuition may be paid by check (enrollment would occur upon receipt of your check – we cannot accept checks by phone), or by Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover (credit or debit cards can be processed over the phone or online and enrollment would occur immediately when payment by card is processed).
2. I understand that courses are Internet based and conducted on an independent study basis and I may continue my enrollment for a period of 180 days (approximately 6 months). I understand that I can purchase up to three 90-day course extensions after the initial enrollment period. However, for tuition refund purposes the period of enrollment is 6 months and the following charges will apply:
 - a. If I withdraw within the 6 months of enrolling, I will be charged for the actual lessons completed. For refund calculation purposes, I must provide evidence of the number of lessons completed.
 - b. If I fail to notify the school that I am withdrawing within 6 months of enrolling I understand that I shall be charged for the total number of contracted lessons and lesson materials.
3. To complete the program, I must clock the required number of instructional hours and complete all required quizzes and final exams (if applicable).

Nevada Student Refund Policy

All course cancellation and refund requests must be submitted in WRITING to Mbition Learn Real Estate's Refund Specialist.

NRS 394.449 Requirements of policy for refund by institutions.

1. Each postsecondary education institution shall have a policy for refunds which at least provides
 - a. That if the institution has substantially failed to furnish the training program agreed upon in the enrollment agreement, the institution shall refund the student all the money the student has paid.
 - b. That if a student cancels his or her enrollment before the start of the training program, the institution shall refund to the student all the money the student has paid, minus 10 percent of the tuition agreed upon in the enrollment agreement or \$150, whichever is less.
 - c. That if the student withdraws or is expelled by the institution after the start of the training program and before the completion of more than 60 percent of the program, the institution shall refund to the student a pro rate amount of the tuition agreed upon in the enrollment agreement, minus 10 percent of the tuition or \$150, whichever is less.
 - d. That if a student withdraws or is expelled by the institution after completion of more than 60 percent of the training program, the institution is not required to refund the student any money and may charge the student the entire cost of the tuition agreed upon in the enrollment agreement.
2. If a refund is owed pursuant to subsection 1, the institution shall pay the refund to the person or entity who paid the tuition within 15 calendar days after the:

- a. Date of cancellation by a student of his or her enrollment;
 - b. Date of termination by the institution of the enrollment of a student;
 - c. Last day of an authorized leave of absence if the student fails to return after the period of authorization absence; or
 - d. Last day of attendance of a student, which is applicable.
3. Books, educational supplies or equipment for individual use are not included in the policy for refund required by subsection 1, and a separate refund must be paid by the institution to the student if those items were not used by the student. Disputes must be resolved by the Administrator for refunds required by this subsection on a case-by-case basis.
4. For the purposes of this section:
- a. The period of a student’s attendance must be measured from the first day of instruction as set forth in the enrollment agreement through the student’s last day of actual attendance, regardless of absences.
 - b. The period of time for a training program is the period set forth in the enrollment agreement
 - c. Tuition must be calculated using the tuition and fees set forth in the enrollment agreement and does not include books, educational supplies or equipment that is listed separately from the tuition and fees.

Career/Placement Assistance

The school does not aid or provide counseling for graduates in finding job leads or arranging interviews with potential employers. Current law prohibits any school from guaranteeing job placement as an inducement to enroll students.

Credit for Previous Education and Training

Mbition Learn Real Estate does not grant credit for previous education and training. Also, Mbition Learn Real Estate does not guarantee transferability of its credits to any other education institution. Transferability is up to the receiving institution.
