Enrollment and Fees

Admission is open to any qualified applicant. No qualified person may be excluded from enrollment on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, gender identity and/or expression, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

1. Be at least 18 years of age.
2. Submit required forms (Enrollment Agreements, etc.) as required by state postsecondary regulations.
3. Pay appropriate fees.

It is advisable to contact your state's Appraisal Board, Real Estate Commission or Financial Services Board for information specific to becoming an appraiser or real estate agent in your state.
For this on-line program, all students must complete the enrollment agreement form prior to starting the course.

All course lessons must be completed within 180 days (6 months) from the date of enrollment. Course access will expire at midnight on the 180th day after enrollment. Students must contact Mbition within 30 days of expiration to obtain an extension. Access to the course after 30 days from initial expiration requires re-enrollment. A discounted fee of 50% of the original purchase price will be charged.

The maximum time to complete a course, including any eligible extensions and completion of the final exam, is 12 months (180 days + purchase of three 60-day extensions). The 60-day extension

period begins from the date your course originally expires. It is your responsibility to contact Mbition Learn Real Estate to request an extension. It is recommended you purchase the extension immediately after the course has expired in order to be able to have the full 60 days of the extension. Access to a course after the extension period(s) requires re-enrollment. A discounted re-enrollment fee of 50% of the original purchase price will be charged.

If you are not eligible for an extension due to regulatory requirements, then you will be eligible to re-purchase the course with a discounted re-enrollment fee at 50% of the original purchase price.

As our courses are taught via distance education, students do not have the calendar constraints common to in-class courses such as program start/end dates and beginning/end dates for terms.

Attendance Policy

To receive credit for a course, you must complete 100% of it and pass the final exam. Under no circumstances will you receive any credit for courses in which you completed less than 100% of the lessons and/or failed the final exam. We do not have a leave of absence policy or probationary period.

Information on the final exam requirements may be found on the course instruction page under the course document tab. All prelicensing and qualifying courses require a final exam. However, for continuing education courses, final exam requirements vary by state. Information on final exam requirements may be found on the course instruction page under the course document tab.

Terms of Agreement

1. Mbition LLC offers several payment options and tuition is required in full prior to the start of any program. Tuition may be paid by check (enrollment would occur upon receipt of your check – we cannot accept checks by phone), or by Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover (credit or debit cards can be processed over the phone or online and enrollment would occur immediately when payment by card is processed).
2. I understand that courses are Internet based and conducted on an independent study basis and I may continue my enrollment for a period of 180 days (approximately 6 months). I understand that I can purchase up to three 90-day course extensions after the initial enrollment period. However, for tuition refund purposes the period of enrollment is 6 months and the following charges will apply:
 1. If I withdraw within the 6 months of enrolling, I will be charged for the actual lessons completed. For refund calculation purposes, I must provide evidence of the number of lessons completed.
 2. If I fail to notify the school that I am withdrawing within 6 months of enrolling I understand that I shall be charged for the total number of contracted lessons and lesson materials.
3. To complete the program, I must clock the required number of instructional hours and complete all required quizzes and final exams (if applicable).

Applicants may be denied an inspector license based upon criminal history. If you have any criminal offenses, unpaid judgement, had discipline taken against a professional or occupational license, or
